On Wednesday, a delegation comprising student representatives from Year 3-6, dedicated teachers, administrators, and a parent visited Muhimbili's Ujasiri House. Here, we witnessed the impact of our collective efforts as we met some of the 22 children currently residing in the recovery house. Your generous financial and material donations enabled us to purchase essential anti-cancer medicines, including paclitaxel, valued at over 4 million. Medical tests were also covered, contributing significantly to the children's fight against cancer. The warmth and gratitude from the parents, especially those from regions like Ruvuma, Rukwa, and Tabora, were deeply touching. One parent expressed, "We have no relatives here; people like you are our relatives in Dar. May God bless you abundantly."

While our work is not complete, we are left with a sense of fulfillment, knowing that we have made a positive impact on the lives of these resilient children. Until our next endeavor, let's hold onto the powerful message that childhood cancer is curable.
